<b>Skates</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Figure and hockey rink skates are available for the lesson program and Parent Skate at no additional charge as long as supplies last.</li> <li>• Students are encouraged to provide their own skates, with strong ankle support and a snug fit. Purchased skates should be sharpened before the first lesson.</li> <li>• <b>For information on purchasing new/used skates and sharpening blades, please contact the Binghamton Figure Skating Club (see below).</b></li> </ul>
<b>Clothing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Should allow for freedom of movement. Layered clothing is best.</li> <li>• Helmets/padding are strongly encouraged, especially for children 5 and under.</li> <li>• <u>Gloves/mittens</u> are <b>strongly recommended for hand protection</b>. Gloves can be purchased at the registration table.</li> <li>• Wear thin socks for a snug skate fit and better ankle support. Heavy socks can cause rubbing and a loose skate fit around the ankles.</li> </ul>
<b>Rules</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The “practice” half-hour is for practicing skating techniques learned during lessons and for Parent Skate. Horseplay will not be tolerated. Safety is key to continued program success. Offenders will receive one warning. Failure to comply can result in removal from the program, without refund.</li> <li>• Food, beverages, and gum are not permitted on the ice. Only service animals are permitted at the rink.</li> </ul>
<b>Info</b>	A staffed information table will be set up during all <b>Learn-to-Skate</b> sessions to assist you. You can also contact the Binghamton Figure Skating Club (see below), if you have any questions about programs, fees, payments or “GIFT CERTIFICATES”.
<b>Scholarships</b>	A memorial scholarship program is available for children, who, for financial reasons, may not be able to otherwise participate in the Learn-to-Skate Program. Contact the Binghamton Figure Skating Club for more information. (See below.)

Call and leave a message to see if space is available.</li> <li>• <b>Since class space is limited, registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis.</b></li> <li>• <b>CONFIRMATION NOTICES ARE NOT MAILED. Plan to attend on day selected, unless you receive notification otherwise.</b></li> <li>• <b>The Ice Center only closes if Broome County is under a <u>State of Emergency with a Travel Ban for the City of Binghamton</u>. Classes are held if the Ice Center is open.</b></li> <li>• Your name(s) will automatically be added to the Binghamton Figure Skating Club mailing list for future skating seasons.</li> </ul>

**Binghamton Figure Skating Club Learn-to-Skate USA Program Information**

- 4 years of age through adults are welcomed and encouraged. (3 year-olds with permission of Director.)
- Classes are organized by age and ability with student level placement occurring during the first class.
- 3 to 5 year-olds have play-based Snowplow Sam curricula. Adults have separate classes.
- Class sizes typically range from 5 to 8 students. Student levels are adjusted as needed.
- Classes are 1 hour long, consisting of ½ hour of instruction and ½ hour of practice time.
- 6 Basic levels with approximately 5 skills at each level. Skills for each level are taught during each class.
- Beginning levels/basic techniques: proper way to fall down, get up, skate across the rink and stop.
- Upper levels/advanced techniques: backward skating, crossovers, edges, turns, beginning spins/jumps.
- Students advance to higher levels as they demonstrate proficiency of ALL skills in a level.
- Fees cover ice cost, insurance, instruction, materials and FREE rental of rink skates (as available).
- Cancellation Policy: No refunds after second week of each session. \$25 part of each \$90 not refundable.
- ★ **1st class, come ½ hour early:** find out your class/time/location on rink; get fitted for skates.
- ★ **Upon completion of each level, a badge may be purchased for \$1.00 at the registration table.**
- ★ **We will allow one make-up lesson per session. Stop at the Information Table to sign up.**
- ★ **Session S-4 and T-2 skaters may sign up to be in our Spring Exhibition at the end of March.**
